



Directions to Sabattis Adventure Camp

From New Jersey:

- Route 287 North to Route 87 North/NY Thruway– you will get onto Route 87 at the NJ/NY border
- At Albany the NY State Thruway and Route 87 North will separate – make sure you get off the Thruway for Route 87 North.
- From Route 87 North, take exit 23, the Warrensburg exit for Route 28. The camp is approximately 75 miles or 1 hour and 45 mins. from this exit.
- Stay on Route 28 until you pickup Route 30 (Do not take Route 28N)



*Turn Right here for Route 30*

- Continue on Route 30 passing through Blue Mountain Lake and Long Lake.
- After turning Left into Long Lake,



*Turn Left hereto stay on Route 30*

stay on Route 30 for 7 more miles; then make a left turn on top of a hill (as the road starts to curve to the right) onto Sabattis Road.

The sign for the left hand turn (on the left side of the road) reads “Sabattis Road” – brown sign with gold lettering. Also look for a white sign with black SAC lettering.



- Proceed on this road for 3 miles. The road will go to the right and open up to a large lake (Little Tupper Lake) on the left side.
- Just to the other side of the lake (after crossing a bridge) you will come to a 3 way intersection. At the intersection, look for the white and black SAC sign. Turn to the left, keeping the large lake on your left side.
- As you drive along the road, you will pass Whitney DEC Headquarters. After about 2 miles the road will turn to dirt/gravel. Once the road turns to dirt/gravel – the camp driveway is 3.2 miles away.
- After you pass Lake Lila on the left, the next left will be the driveway for camp. There is a large silver mailbox and the camp sign at the entrance. If you cross a bridge with a lake on both sides – you went too far.



- Continue on the camp driveway – passing the Rifle Range and turn Right at the “Y”. Continue into camp, following the driveway in between the red barn and brown Health Lodge. Park in the Temporary Parking area (see signs) and check in with the Camp Office.
