#### Day camp is great for any Scout!

This includes first year Scouts who may not be quite ready for overnight camp and want to get a head start on their Boy Scout adventure. Day camp is also an opportunity for older Scouts who cannot stay overnight, but want to work on advancement or just enjoy the program areas at camp.

#### Trailblazer Day Camp

at Camp Somers in Stanhope, NJ

is a weeklong adventure. First year Scouts can work on Tenderfoot through First Class rank requirements, outdoor skills, and an age appropriate merit badge. Older Scouts



can work on merit badges. Everyone gets to have fun in the camp program areas. **Bus transportation is provided** from more than 45 locations throughout Morris, Sussex, and NW Somerset counties. Five sessions are offered between July 6 and August 7 from 8:45 am until 3:45 pm. Bring your own lunch.

**Winnebago Scout Reservation** in Rockaway, NJ offers a flexible approach to day camp. New Scouts are encouraged to come for a full week, but any Scout can come for a week or for specific full or half days to complete merit badges, work on advancement, or just participate in program areas. **You provide your own transportation.** Camp runs for four weeks from July 6 to July 31. Drop off Scouts after 8:30 am and pick up by 5:45 pm. Times are flexible to fit your needs. Bring your own lunch, or the camp can provide meals for a fee.

# Trail to Eagle Camp

**Trail to Eagle Camp** is a weeklong camp designed to help Scouts achieve their goal of attaining the Eagle rank. You form a troop in camp with like-minded Scouts and our experienced adult leaders. Get a jump start on advancement and learn what needs to be done to achieve the rank of Eagle Scout.



We guide you through the advancement process and help prepare you for your service project. Focused discussions with the leaders, staff and fellow troop members help explore your challenges and drive toward your Scouting goals.



## All Eagle required merit badges are offered.

Scouts must review the requirements and prerequisites before camp to determine which ones need to be done outside of camp to complete each merit badge. The camp has four sessions from July 5 to August 1. Each week is limited to 24 Star or Life Scouts who are at least 13 years old as of July 1, 2015. Sign up early!

# Backwoods Engineering Camp

Do you want to solve engineering problems using simple machines and tools? Would you like to build bridges, towers, rafts, derricks and catapults or trebuchets using spars, ropes and your own hands? If so, **Backwoods Engineering Camp** is for you!



This unique STEM experience is only offered the week of August 9 - 15. During the week, you'll learn

ways to use the six simple machines in backwoods construction. You will apply the techniques to design and build large pioneering projects. You also get to practice teamwork and leadership, and have plenty of fun.



Scouts form a special troop at camp for the week, and will also participate in several campwide and fun activities at Camp Somers. A camp t-shirt and a group photo are included.

Space is limited to 24 First Class or above Scouts. This popular program sells out every year, so sign up early.
