Adirondack Trek Fees

New per person fees for treks with more than 7 people

| Fee Type | Early |
|---|------------------|
| Hiking trek (includes up to 7 people) | \$2,900 per trek |
| Canoeing trek (includes up to 7 people) | \$3,100 per trek |
| Extra person (up to 10 people total) | \$400 per person |

- ◆ A \$650 non-refundable deposit reserves a trek
- ◆ 2nd non-refundable payment of \$850 is due 1/16/2015
- ◆ Deposit and 2nd payment are applied to total fee
- ◆ Final balance must be paid by 4/30/2015
- ◆ Late fee is \$50 per person for payments after 4/30/2015
- ◆ Hiking treks are limited to 7 people
- ◆ Canoeing treks can have 7-10 people, depending on the trek
- ◆ Treks that use canoes for all or part of the trek are considered canoeing treks
- ◆ **Watchu Sabattis Adirondack Treks** with a minimum of 8 people receive a \$200 trek discount

In addition to our Adirondack Trek program, Sabattis Adventure Camp offers a terrific troop summer camp for Scouts of all ages. Sabattis comprises 1,250 acres surrounded by wilderness and includes a 200-acre

crystal clear lake. Our large private campsites – many are on the lake – provide an awe inspiring location for your troop's summer camp. Wake to the sounds of loons calling across the lake, see wildlife, try the polar bear swim, mountain bike to Lake Lila, and take in the view from Charley's Mountain.



Traditional patrol style cooking, and sleeping in troop provided tents give Scouts the opportunity to work together and polish their camping skills. Sabattis' unique program offers merit badges and advancement in the morning, and lots of fun open activities in the afternoon.

Adirondack Treks at Sabattis Adventure Camp

Based at **Sabattis Adventure Camp**, our thrilling trek program provides weekly high adventure treks in the Adirondack Park. Many crews choose one of our popular **canoeing** treks. Others prefer **hiking** treks where you can backpack or bag some of the 46 Adirondack High Peaks. Leisurely **fish-ing** treks are also available. Pick one of our planned routes, or custom design your own with our expert assistance. You can also take a combined hiking and canoeing trek.



You put together a crew that includes at least one adult 21 years of age or older. All participants must be at least 13 years old. If you need help filling out your crew, Patriots' Path Council will try to help. A trained Adirondack Voyageur accompanies all treks. The Voyageur can serve as a second adult for two deep leadership.



All treks require a minimum of 7 participants. Many canoeing treks can have up to 10 participants. We

also offer **Wilderness Canoeing Treks** which are limited to 7 people. These are perfect for those who want to visit more remote locations. Hiking treks are limited to 7 people.



Treks are conducted in accordance with the Outdoor Code and the Leave No Trace philosophy. Our treks are approved under the strict regulations

of the New York State Health Department, the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation, and the Boy Scouts of America.

Need Financial Assistance to send your son to camp? Patriots' Path Council can help. The Warren Wheeler Adventuershship is available for families to help pay the cost of attending our camps. The deadline is 4/1/2015.

Breathtaking Adirondack Park Setting


Encompassing an area larger than six of our states; the six million+ acre Adirondack Park is the largest park in the continental USA. It is about a five and one half hour drive from northern New Jersey. There are more than 3,000 lakes, and 6,000 miles of streams and rivers. Many areas within the park are devoid of settlements and are distant from paved roads. The park includes over 2,000 miles of hiking trails that comprise the largest trail system in the nation.



The High Peaks Region features 46 mountains with elevations greater than 4,000 feet. Best of all, many of the finest parts of the Adirondacks are readily accessible from Sabattis!

Top Notch Trek Equipment

We supply trail food, cooking gear, bear bags and lines, water jugs, a first aid kit, and most other group equipment needed by the trek crew. You are encouraged to bring your own back-packing stoves, but we can supply them if needed. For canoeing treks, **ultralight Kevlar canoes**, PFDs, and paddles are included.



Crews supply their own personal equipment including tents, sleeping bags and packs. In base camp, we provide camp cooking equipment and wall tents on platforms with cots. Detailed equipment check-lists are on our web site.
