



# Summer Camp Youth Protection Training Requirement

The Patriots' Path Council continues to be a national leader in youth protection. We believe that it is our top priority to protect the safety of our children and educate as many people as possible about youth protection.

The council leadership, along with the youth protection and risk management committees, have agreed upon the following addition to our council's youth protection policy.

**The Patriots' Path Council will require all adults staying overnight at any Patriots' Path Council Summer Camp to be current in their youth protection training. Proof of current training will be required at check-in.**

Online youth protection is available at [www.myscouting.org](http://www.myscouting.org). You can log-in using your existing username. If you do not have a username, it is easy to create one. If you are a parent who is not registered with the Boy Scouts of America, you still must complete the training.

**Please print or reprint your completed training certificate and bring to camp.**
