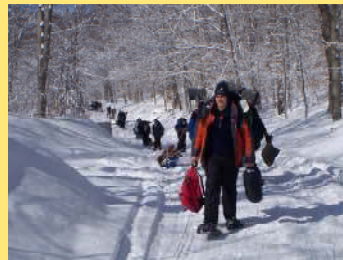


## Start Saving Early

Many high-adventure opportunities can be expensive, but these opportunities should not put a drain on family finances. Most programs require plenty of advance planning. Use this planning time to start saving early.

- A \$1,975 adventure costs approximately \$3.60 per day if you save for 18 months

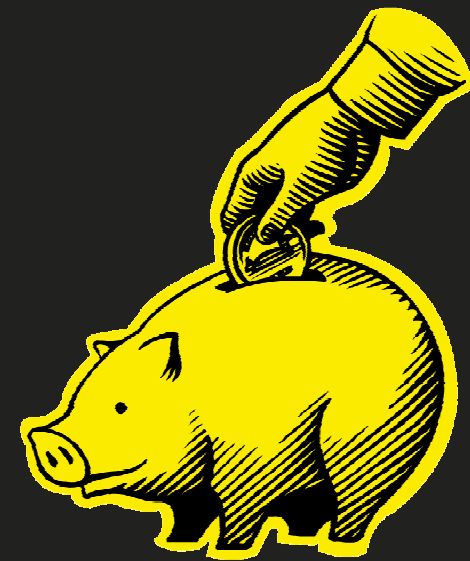
