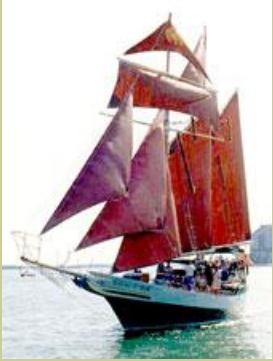

Early on July 17th our crew will depart from Newark Liberty Airport for an arrival in Miami where we board private transportation for our scenic 2-hour journey to the Florida Sea Base. Along the way, we will stop for a quick lunch break.

Upon our arrival, we will all take the BSA swim test, have a snorkeling lesson, and be issued our "sea bags" for use on board our vessel.

The first night you will comfortably rest in an air-conditioned dorm before meeting our boat the next morning. You then board our tall-masted sailing vessel and "shove off" from the dock to begin our adventure toward Key West and back. Everyone will take turns cooking in the galley and "swabbing the decks", along with other shipboard duties, including providing a nightly anchor watch. Hopefully, we can pull in a fish or two to supplement the plentiful meals that will be provided. All along the way, you will be swimming, snorkeling, and learning to sail.

In Key West you will be granted "shore leave" to explore the historic town.

Your last night, you will enjoy a big luau dinner and closing program. Each crew performs a skit or leads a song and everyone receives a commemorative Sea Base patch. Once again, you will sleep in the air-conditioned dorm facilities.

After breakfast, on July 24th, we will board our transportation back to the airport.
